KEY REMINDERS

Free Parking Available on the North Side of Hwy 44 – Follow Signs

- “Athlete Check-In” is open at the **Race Site** from **6:00 AM – 7:15 AM**
- Entries cannot be transferred to other athletes.
- Must present a photo I.D. (*If you are picking up a packet for someone else – Bring a note & photocopy of their Driver’s License*)
- Bib Numbers must be pinned on the **FRONT** of your clothes and visible at the finish line.
- Do NOT remove the foam on the back of your bib, this is your timing chip

Course Cutoff Times

Runners/Walkers on the course after 1:30pm will be offered a ride. Course support will no longer be available.

The Finish Line will remain open until 2:00pm. Please understand that no times will be recorded after 2:00pm.



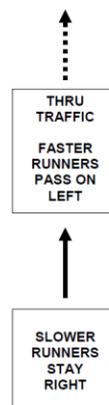
AID STATIONS

The run course will have mile markers and Aid Stations approximately every mile staffed with friendly volunteers offering you encouragement and refreshments. Stations will have Water, Gatorade, Bananas, Oranges, Fig Newton's, Band-Aids & Vaseline. Communication between aid stations and the base station, located at the Finish Line is available to runners experiencing medical or other problems.

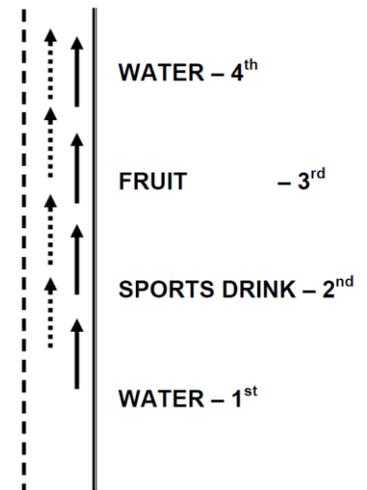
RESTROOMS

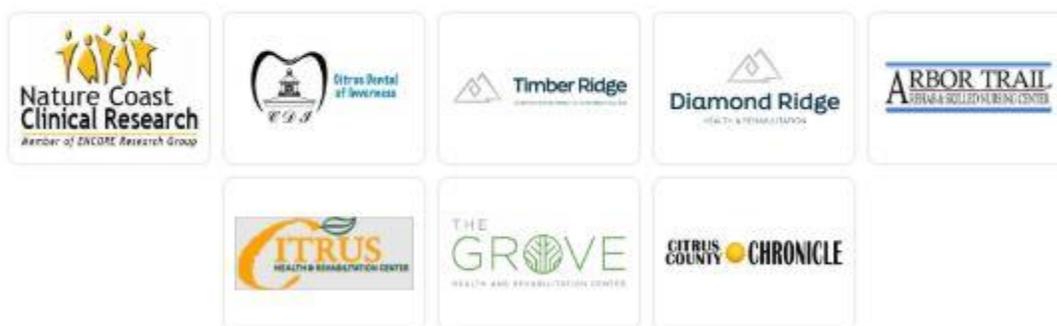
